**Cancellation/Refund Policy:**

Supplies, snacks, and staffing, are all based on accurate counts. Last minute cancellations and no-shows do not allow for accurate planning and use of our resources. This also does not allow us to accommodate kids on the waiting list. **Unless we receive notice the Friday before camp week, (Thursday for Monday's camp) that your child will not be attending, you will NOT receive a refund.**

*Alternative Funding Options:*  
State subsidies for qualifying families, as well as reduced rates, scholarships, volunteer exchanges, etc. are available so that all interested students may participate in our programs. Please indicate on the registration form if you wish to explore these options., We will help you with the application process.

**Notes to Parents and Guardians:** Vermont weather is unpredictable. We run our camps rain or shine, so please send your child dressed appropriately - layers, winter boots, warm clothes, extra clothes, indoor shoes, hats, and gloves.

- We need a current registration/medical form for your child.
- You provide lunch and we provide 2 healthy snacks.
- Please let us know how we may best help your child enjoy camp and discuss any special needs.
- In the event of field trips, transportation and admission fees are included. CC field trips are money-free activities. We will not go to gift shops, vending machines, arcades, etc.. Personal audio, phones, and video games are allowed at your own risk, and only on the bus.
