

Transportation Plan 2020/2021

Rumney Memorial School uses a web application called **PickUp Patrol** for student dismissals. This web application allows for smoother and easier dismissal for students and school staff. It also makes it easier for families to make changes to after school dismissal plans.

PickUp Patrol

- ★ **Convenient:** Change day of plans, future dismissal plans, and plans that repeat on multiple dates.
- ★ **Automated:** Notify the school of any late arrivals, early dismissals, and absences.
- ★ **Safe and Secure:** All student information is protected and the program is entirely administered by our staff. In addition, you will receive a confirmation email each time you or a staff member submit a plan change for your student.

A welcome letter will be sent to parents/guardians of new Rumney students. This welcome letter will include the hyperlink and log-in information needed to sign-up for PickUp Patrol. Accounts for returning Rumney parents/guardians will remain the same. Any questions regarding a student pick-up plan will result in a delay until we can confirm changes that are not clear in PickUp Patrol.

Policies

PreK and Kindergarten students will not be dropped off unless an authorized adult (18 years or older) is present to greet them. PreK and Kindergarten students **will be returned to the school** if there is no adult present at the afternoon bus stop. Parents will be called to pick-up their student(s) at the school.

WCUUSD requires that students riding the bus **wear seat belts and masks** at all times. Additionally, parents/guardians are asked to perform a **health screening** of their students every morning before they ride the bus. Parents are asked to reinforce and support the importance of students' use of seat belts, masks, and following all the bus guidelines.

PreK students may ride the school bus. PreK students riding the bus must be comfortable getting on and off themselves, buckling their own seatbelt, and wearing their mask. PreK families are responsible for providing transportation both ways if students are not able to ride the bus independently.
