1. Treasurer's Report

4. Outreach for Title 1 funding

Dinah has contacted 57 of the 90 families here in Calais to help give information concerning the free or reduced lunch form that goes home at the beginning of the year. The program is 11 students short of meeting the funding requirements for title 1 funds. She reported to the group that 20 were already enrolled, 30 were over the income but 17 thought they may be eligible but had not filled out the form and sent in. She is asking families to send them in this week so Cat may have them for planning for next year's budget. Dinah plans on attending the school board meeting on Dec 20th 6 to 8pm at CES.
